



WHAT TO BRING TO KESHER SCOUTING:

Please **label everything with your name**. Anything left at camp will become *hefker*.

THE FOLLOWING ARE MUSTS:

- Siddur & Tefillin
- Sleeping bag
- Backpacker's foam pad (Use under sleeping bag)
- Poncho or raincoat (optional: rain pants)
- Prescription medications
- Hiking shoes / Boots
- Waterproof footwear (Could be the hiking shoes)
- Extra shoes (Could be old sneakers)
- Non-leather shoes for Tisha b'Av (**not** sandals)
- Shabbos Clothing (**Please do not bring expensive clothing. We cannot take responsibility for its care.**)
- Official Scout summer uniform:
 - 1 Scout shirt (long or short) with green shoulder loops
 - 1 Scout pants (long) and Scout belt
- Boy Scout Handbook (Buy at scout shop with uniform)
- A windbreaker/light jacket and a fleece sweatshirt
- Socks (athletic)
- Underwear
- 8 Shirts (not incl. Shabbos. Also bring appropriate t-shirts)
- At least 1 long sleeve t-shirt
- Swimsuit (1 or 2) (optional: goggles/nose plugs)
- 1 or 2 hats (baseball style)
- Tough long pants (2 in addition to the Scout pants)
- Extra pants (2 more)
- Warm pajamas or sweat-shirt & sweat-pants
- Toilet Kit containing all personal needs:
 - Soap and container (Liquid soap recommended)
 - Toothbrush, toothpaste, hair brush, shampoo, etc.
- Towels (for waterfront, showers & hands/face)
- Flashlight (with spare batteries & bulb)
- Canteen (or 2 1-liter plastic soda bottles) 2-3 liters of water in any combination of canteen, bladder, and/or durable water bottles.
- Sunscreen lotion
- Hiking backpack (**recommended**) or large day pack
- Small** foot locker (**recommended**) or duffel bag
- 20 postcards & stamps (Write home!)

Note: Please bring 10-11 days worth of clothing. Extra clothing makes tent cleanliness challenging.

OPTIONAL BUT RECOMMENDED:

- Insect repellent lotion (DEET preferred) **No sprays!**
- Calamine or Caladryl lotion (If you forget to use the DEET)
- Calling card
- Terry robe for swimming
- Sunglasses with headband. (Especially important for the whitewater canoe trip.)
- Wrist watch (An inexpensive waterproof watch that can **stay on your wrist** while swimming & showering.)
- Inexpensive camera, film and batteries
- Sewing kit (Needles, thread, safety pins, etc.)
- Personal First Aid Kit (See Scout Handbook)
- Ground cloth (Old shower curtain or plastic sheet)
- Pocket knife (Not larger than a 2" blade. Only used with Totin' Chip)
- Compass
- Pen/pencil and 3 notebooks
- Fishing gear
- Small board games
- Frisbee
- Fanny pack or day pack
- Spending money

PLEASE LEAVE AT HOME:

DO NOT BRING ANY OF THESE THINGS!*

- Bows & arrows, or sheath & survival knives.
- Fireworks or flammable liquids (e.g. lighters)
- Any electronics (Including, but not limited to, radios, walkie talkies, Mp3 Players, electronic games, phones & computers.)
- Cards of any type (playing cards, trading cards, etc.)
- Water guns or water balloons.
- Sleeveless shirts
- Food - **DO NOT** bring or mail any food or drink!
